

Compliance Institute Southern Africa Awards CRITERIA AND PROCESS

The Compliance Institute Southern Africa once again invites nominations for the Compliance Awards for the third consecutive year. The winners will be announced at a gala dinner to be hosted on 29 August at Vodacom World Events, The Dome in Midrand.

The categories for the Compliance Awards are:

- 1. Compliance Officer of the Year
- 2. Innovative Compliance Team of the Year

NOMINATIONS CLOSE ON 31 MAY 2024.

1. Objective of the Awards

Honours the Compliance Officer (CO) in the compliance profession and recognises outstanding compliance officers and compliance teams from across Southern Africa.

2. The Awards

- Winners are announced at the Annual Awards and Graduation ceremony on 29 August 2024.
- A certificate is issued to the winners.
- Publicity coverage and speaking opportunities.
- Appointed as CISA ambassador(s)
- Profiled on the CISA website, social media channels, newsletter, and events.
- Compliance Officer of the Year
 - An invitation to attend the annual conference as a speaker and as the CEO's guest (complimentary)
 - One year's free CISA membership

3. Criteria

3.1 Compliance Officer of the Year

- Must ideally be a Chief Compliance Officer, or Head of Compliance, must have been in this position for at least 5 years.
- Must be able to demonstrate compliance competency and have a proven track record.

- Demonstrate innovation, professionalism and commitment to their employers / clients and the profession.
- Knowledge of wider industry and business environment
- Ability to be an ambassador for the compliance profession.

3.2 Innovative Compliance Team of the Year

- The work acknowledged must have been completed in the past 18 months and must be ratified by the organisation.
- The award recognises excellent work that is innovative or has achieved great success.
- The award is given to an organisation and not an individual.

4. Rules

- Open to all compliance officers and teams
- Nominees' track record and reputation must be well documented and vetted.
- Nominee(s) may nominate themselves provided that the nomination has been ratified and approved.
- Nominee(s) must avail themselves for an interview by the panel of judges, should the judging panel deem an interview necessary.
- Conflicts of interest to be declared.
- Nominees must be available to attend the Awards and Graduation ceremony in person or virtually.
- CISA may call for confidentiality agreements to be signed if and when necessary.
- Winners must consent to being profiled in social media and other channels.
- Any request for additional information to support the nomination must be responded to timeously. Failure to provide additional information when requested may result in the nomination being excluded.

5. Nomination process

5.1 Compliance Officer of the Year

Nominations by peers / manager / employer

- Describe the nominee's attributes.
- What are the nominee's professional accomplishments?
- What initiatives is the nominee currently working on that will significantly impact the compliance industry / organisation?
- What legacy will the nominee leave for the compliance industry?
- How is the nominee contributing to the industry by knowledge sharing, mentoring, etc?
- Provide an executive summary. This is mandatory.
- Most senior relevant person in the organisation must ratify and approve the nomination.
- Nominee to accept the nomination and T&C's
- Submit nominations by **31 May 2024.**
- Evaluation by panel of judges
- Judges may interview the nominees on various topics and matters of importance to the compliance community, e.g., regulatory changes / developments, technical information, trends, etc.
- Interviews will be held at the Institute or virtually if requested.

5.2 Innovative Compliance Team of the Year

- What is the initiative being nominated?
- Has the initiative been completed in the last 18 months?
- What has the initiative accomplished?
- How does the initiative fit into the overall strategy to improve compliance in the organisation?
- What are the next steps the organisation would like to take with regards to this initiative, if any?
- What effect has the initiative had on the organisation?
- What effect has the initiative had on the compliance industry?
- Executive summary to be provided. This is mandatory.

6. Submission of Nominations
